

Shapel Tide Clocks

Caring for the Timber in your Tide Clock

The timber base on your Shapel Tide Clock has been hand made in Australia by me. In our workshop, Artisans On The Hill, my wife and I create interesting, functional pieces for our Gallery and teach interesting crafts in our workshops.

The timber in your clock is Malunak (aka Fiji Mahogany) which is sourced from plantation grown, ecologically sustainable forests in South East Asia. This industry provides a welcome income for the locals in these regions.

The finish is an oil finish (I want the finish to be IN the timber, not ON the timber). This allows the timber to breathe and will require, from time to time, a freshen up with a good quality furniture wax or oil.

Please keep your Tide Clock away from direct sunlight wherever possible to maintain the quality of your timber.
